## **Election**

Following interview, three applicants were declared candidates for election. One candidate subsequently withdrew prior to an election being held. The equalities information for the two candidates who stood for election is being withheld in order to protect their personal data.

An election was held between 21 and 27 January 2021 with an electorate of the staff, students, sabbatical officers and court members of the University conducted in accordance with Court's election regulations.

Pamela Woodburn was elected Chair of the University Court for an initial three year period, commencing 1 February 2021, having received 291 votes. A total of 536 votes were cast from an electorate of 7288, representing a 7.35% turnout.
